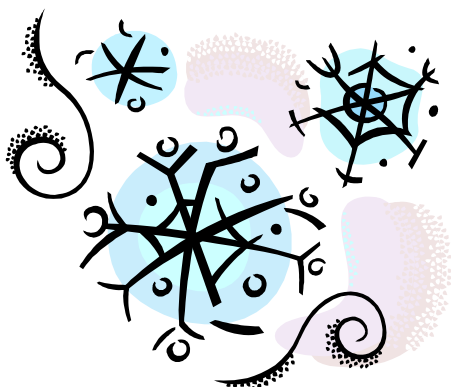
### **Wanted! Used ink cartridges**
